RE: Potential Consideration of Priority Candidate's Appointment on April 26, 2024

The Nebraska Open Meetings Act (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-1407 to 84-1414) requires the Board of Regents' give reasonable advance publicized notice of the time, place of meeting, and an agenda of subjects known at the time of the publicized notice. Board of Regents' Standing Rule 2.4 requires at least five (5) days public notice prior to the meeting.

The purpose of today's notice of meeting is to give reasonable advance notice to the public of the Board's potential consideration of the President Priority Candidate's appointment. As you know, Dr. Jeffrey P. Gold is undergoing the enhanced public scrutiny process pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 85-106.06. Dr. Gold will be participating in a final series of public forums on Wednesday, April 24:
