PROGRAM NUMBERS FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

PROCEDURES UNFP 6.3.6.9

I. Reference and Application:

- A. Department of Administrative Services requires separate program numbers for each project \$500,000 and greater.
- B. On November 7, 2008, the Board of Regents approved a policy for Capital Planning and Development
- C. Application: The procedures apply to all University capital construction projects funded from current operating budgets, capital construction appropriations, and gifts and bequests.

II. Objectives and Limitations:

- A. The objective of these procedures is to provide guidelines necessary to comply with Board Policy (RP-6.3.6) *Capital Planning and Development* and provide a uniform and effective way to provide budget control and comply with DAS requirements.

III. Procedures

- A. Campuses will obtain a separate 900 program number for each capital construction project with total project costs of \$500,000 or greater funded from current operating budgets, capital construction appropriations, and gifts and bequests.
- B. Capital projects funded from current operating budgets and gifts and bequests, with total project costs less than \$500,000 will be coded to one or more 900 campus program numbers entitled "miscellaneous renovations".
