

BILINGUAL PRESCHOOL – THIRD GRADE EDUCATIONAL FACILITATOR

The University of Nebraska Buffett Early Childhood Institute seeks an individual to join the Buffett Institute and public school staff in implementing the preschool – third grade component of a comprehensive initiative to eliminate or reduce income-based social, cognitive, and achievement gaps among young children at risk in the Learning Community of Douglas and Sarpy Counties. The bilingual preschool – third grade educational facilitator will work on-site at two participating schools in Omaha, NE. The facilitator’s role will emphasize leadership for preschool – third grade instructional practices, including teacher consultation and coaching.

Minimum Qualifications: A bachelor’s degree in fields related to early childhood education and elementary education and five years of highly effective bilingual or dual language teaching at the preschool – third grade levels in schools that serve economically, racially, and linguistically diverse children. Experience as an instructional coach for teachers at the preschool – third grade levels and/or experience in designing and delivering professional development. Commitment to and knowledge of educational practices that are informed by child development research, with an emphasis on preschool – third grade for English language learners. Knowledge of bilingual or dual language education and bilingual fluency (Spanish/English) are required. Preferred qualifications include a master’s degree.
