**IV. INTERVIEW OF GEORGE E. ROSS, PH.D., FOR THE POSITION OF PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA**

Ross and his wife, Elizabeth, to Nebraska and noted that the couple has spent several days visiting each of the NU campuses and meeting with students, faculty, staff and administrators. They also have met with other important constituencies of the university including donors, agricultural leaders, the media and the general public.

Chairman Hawks invited the members of the Board of Regents to introduce themselves and then facilitated the Board's formal interview of Dr. Ross. Board members asked questions in about a dozen topic areas.
