The NU DEAL is a focused, two-year investment in personal growth and development. Participants will refine their leadership skills while interacting within the context of the many subcultures of our multifaceted educational enterprise. The program is intended for individuals from each campus who are currently serving in academic leadership roles (department chairs, center directors, assistant/associate deans) and have interest in expanding their leadership practice and skills.

Four participants from each campus will meet as a cohort four times over two years, and up to monthly in small groups or for campus-specific projectbased learning. The inter-campus fellowship will provide unprecedented access to the macro systems, information and decision-making that drive the actions and performance of the NU system. NU DEAL strengthens relationships, connections and networks broadly across Nebraska.
