The program benefits all employees, guests, and students by providing comprehensive safety information, location alerts, and security assistance via Worldcue® Mobile App, while in travel status for university domestic and international travel.

The selection of our partnership with Crisis24 was determined in collaboration with our four campus Global Engagement Directors. When you make travel arrangements with Fox World Travel or Anthony Travel (UNL Athletics only) your travel information will be sent to Crisis 24. The traveler will receive a welcome email highlighting the benefits of Crisis24. The Travel Office and Fox World Travel collaborated to find a way to utilize those tickets in the form of a universal travel card (UATP). Parking Discount at Eppley

University Travelers will receive a significant discount on parking at Omaha's Eppley Airfield from January 11 through March 15, 2022.

As one of ParkOMA's first online reservation system users, University of Nebraska travelers are being offered a special introductory rate of 50% off daily rates for your choice of walkable covered parking at the North Garage and South Garage or South Economy served with on-demand shuttle bus service. During the introductory period, that is just \$8 per day (regularly \$16) for North Garage and South Garage and only \$3 per day (regularly \$6) for South Economy.
