

COVID Protocol for NU Presidential Events

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, event protocol for Presidential events has been adjusted. Below is a list of health and safety measures that will be in place for the protection of our guests.

- If you are feeling unwell, experiencing any symptoms of Covid-19, or have been exposed to anyone with Covid-19, please stay home.
- In keeping with both UNL campus policy and the City of Lincoln Directed Health Measures, guests are required to wear a mask throughout the event. If guests do not bring one, we will have some available. All guests are expected to wear masks any time they are not eating or drinking.
- Some events may no longer include a cocktail hour. If a cocktail time is needed, a shorter duration will be encouraged (6:30 p.m. arrival with 7 p.m. dinner).
- We ask that guests distance themselves at least 6 feet apart from other guests when possible.
- Bartenders will take beverage orders to discourage large groups congregating at the bar and will serve the beverages to each guest.
- Food will be served by catering staff.
- Hand sanitizer will be available to all attendees and utilization is encouraged upon arrival and throughout the event.
- The event guest total will follow Lincoln's Directed Health Measures.
- Pre-set food items will be limited (i.e. salads and dinner rolls).
- Each attendee will have their own individual condiments (i.e. salt and pepper) to limit passing between guests of any kind.
- All staff, bartenders, and caterers working events will be masked. Additionally, bartenders and caterers will wear gloves throughout the event in serving both food and beverages.
