## UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA SYSTEM

For over 150 years, the University of Nebraska has served the citizens of the state through high-quality, affordable education, research that improves the quality of life for Nebraskans, and engagement with citizens in every county. Thanks to an enduring partnership with the state, along with unprecedented support from the private sector, the university has fulfilled its land grant mission of supporting Nebraskans.



The NU System returns **\$9** for every **\$1** invested by the state legislature.



The NU System generates a **\$5.8B** total annual economic impact.



Nebraska Medicine, an NU affiliate, generates an additional **\$4.5B** total annual economic impact.



**47,000** jobs in Nebraska are supported by the NU System.



One of every **seven** working age Nebraskans are educated by the NU System.



One of every **27** Nebraskans are employed directly or indirectly by the NU System.



The NU System generated **\$164M** in tax revenue to state and local governments in FY2020-21.



The NU System graduates almost **11,000** students each year to fill Nebraska's workforce.



The NU System works with over **75%** of Nebraska's producers to boost productivity.



The NU System empowers **140,000** Nebraska 4-H students with life skills every year.
