Thanks to an enduring partnership with the state, along with unprecedented support from the private sector, the university has fulfilled its land grant mission of supporting Nebraskans.



NU returns **\$7** for every **\$1** invested by the state legislature.



NU generates a **\$4.5B** total annual economic impact.



Nebraska Medicine, an NU affiliate, generates an additional **\$3.1B** total annual economic impact.



38,000 jobs in Nebraska are supported by the University of Nebraska.



NU research generates a **\$400M** annual economic impact, supporting **2,600** jobs statewide.



One of every 26 jobs statewide is supported directly or indirectly by NU.



NU generated **\$154M** in tax revenue to state and local governments in 2018.
